



Data Protection Notice

World Scout Jamboree 2027

The World Scout Jamboree 2027 Contingent Management Team of Scouting Ireland (the “**WSJ Event**”, “**CMT**”, “**we**”, “**us**” or “**our**”) collects and uses information relating to you for a wide variety of purposes in connection with your participation in the World Scout Jamboree 2027. We do this in compliance with our obligations under applicable data protection law. This notice explains what personal data relating to you is collected, the purposes for which it is used, the third parties to whom it may be disclosed, and how you can exercise your rights in relation to your personal data.

Personal Data that we Process

The types of personal data about you that we collect, and process may include:

- (i) your name;
- (ii) your contact details
- (iii) your scout group details
- (iv) your payment details;
- (v) your dietary details;
- (vi) your health details;
- (vii) your passport/visa detail

Purposes of Processing and Legal Basis

The WSJ 2027 contingent will be in place for the preparation, duration and post event review period. During that time, registered members of the Contingent Management Team and Contingent Support Team will act as Data Controllers as defined by the data protection requirements.

The designated Troop Leaders will act as data processors which requires them to ensure the data available to them is kept secured and processed only in accordance with the requirements for management of the event. It also ensures that the data will be removed from all devices at the end of the event.

Recipients of Data

Your data will be transferred to the troop leaders for the agreed purpose of communicating and arranging pre and post event camps. Your data will be transferred to Travel Agents to facilitate the booking of flights.

Retention

The WSJ 2027 Contingent will be in place for the preparation, duration and post event review period. After this time all data held on you will be removed from any device on which it was stored other than the Scouting Ireland Registration System (my.scouts.ie portal) as per the consent of the ‘scout’ and or ‘parent/guardian’ previously gained.

Transfers Abroad

In connection with the above there will be a requirement for information to be supplied to the World Scout Jamboree Event Team based in Poland, which will be in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We may ask you to undertake this transfer of information yourself to ensure best practice is being applied.



Your Rights

You have the following rights, subject to certain restrictions, in relation to your personal data:

- a. the right to access your personal data;
- b. the right to request the rectification and/or erasure of your personal data;
- c. the right to restrict the use of your personal data;
- d. the right to object to the processing of your personal data;
- e. the right to receive your personal data, which you provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to require us to transmit that data to another controller.
